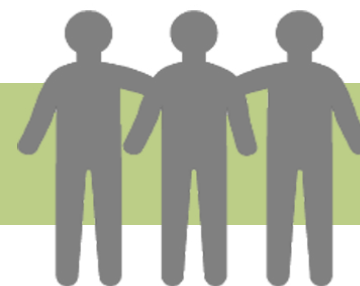

The first BCAN Leadership Summit was held in October 2016 in Rockville, MD.

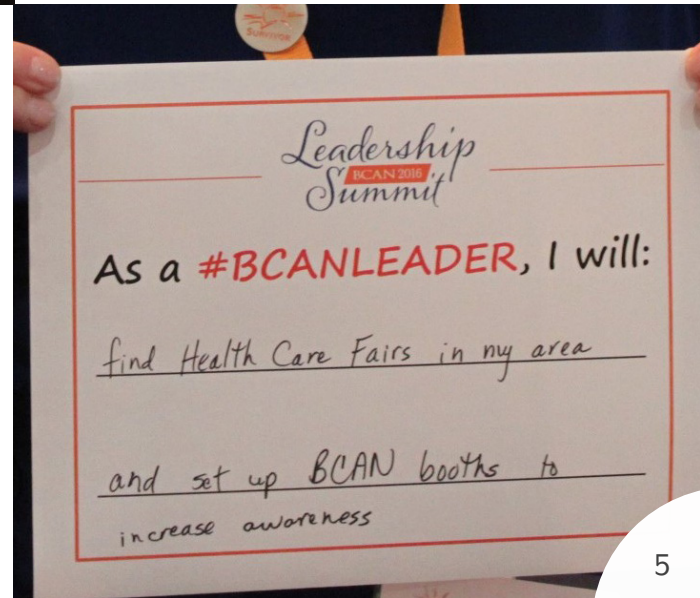


The Summit is a two-day conference to engage, educate and energize bladder cancer survivors and our BCAN volunteers.

Our 2016 Bladder Cancer Research Innovation Award, was presented to David McConkey, PhD, Director at the Johns Hopkins Greenberg Bladder Cancer Institute in Baltimore, MD, for his study “Targeting FGFR3 in Muscle-Invasive Bladder Cancer.”

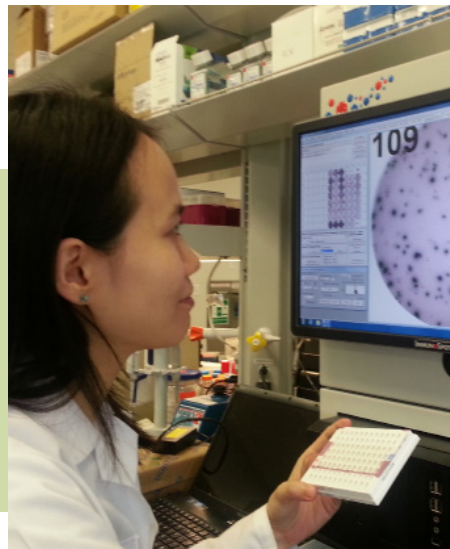
BCAN also provided two Young Investigator Awards, each \$50,000 for one year, promoting the development of early career researchers who are focused on bladder cancer.

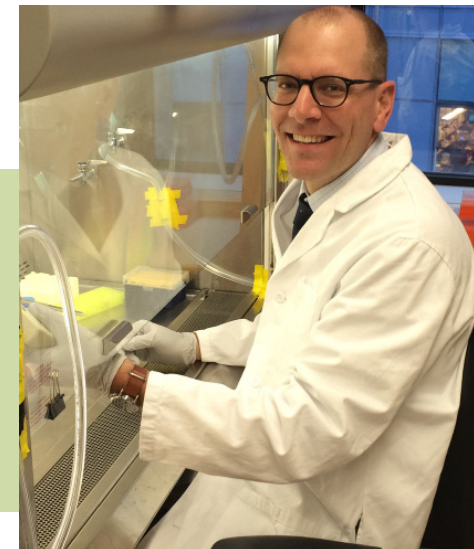

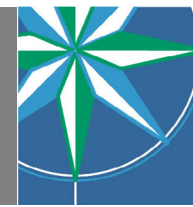

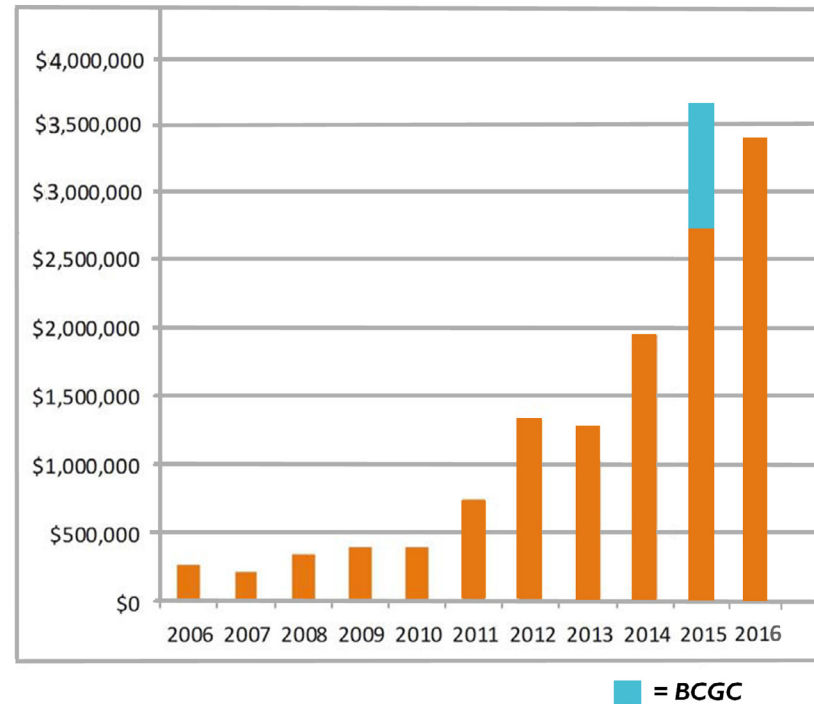

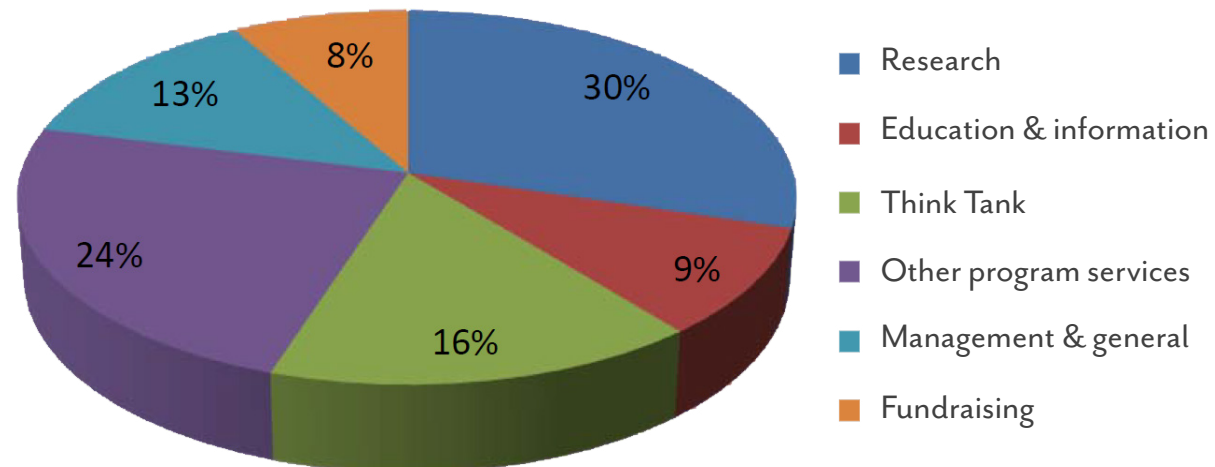
